TITLE: Controlled Substance, Drug and
Alcohol Usage/Possession Policy

DATE ADOPTED/REVISED: June 21, 2006

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CONTROLLED SUBSTANCE, DRUG AND ALCOHOL USAGE/POSSESSION POLICY

The possession or use of all drugs, alcohol and mood altering substances by students while attending all IU schools, programs and classes is prohibited. Students may possess asthma inhalers and self-administered asthma medications prescribed by their physicians. Students may self-administer asthma medication by inhalation with written parental permission and with notice to the school nurse. CCIU reserves the right to restrict possession of asthma inhalers by students if the privilege is abused. Programs and procedures will be maintained to appropriately educate, prevent and intervene in the possession, use and abuse of all drugs, alcohol and mood altering substances by students. The Executive Director is responsible for developing and implementing such procedures.

Dietary supplements, medicines and other substances not requiring a prescription may be administered in intermediate unit schools, programs and classes with parental permission. Medicines that require a prescription may be administered with parental permission and with proper labeling and identification of the prescription. Medicines will be administered by staff according to procedures developed for various intermediate unit schools, programs and classes.
