<p>Verbal sessions include exercises on vocabulary, critical reading comprehension and sentence completion, and the writing components. Verbal sessions meet once a week for eight weeks. Sessions meet once a week for seven weeks. Each class is three hours long.</p> <p>Time: 6:00-9:00 p.m.</p> <p>Day: Wednesdays</p> <p>Dates: January 13, 20, 27; February 3, 10, 17, 24</p> <p>Location: Conestoga High School, Room 166</p> <p>Cost: \$140 per course or \$260 for both courses (includes materials and a \$30 <u>non-refundable</u> registration fee per course).</p> <p>Please note: An additional \$25 (per course) administrative fee will be withheld for courses(s) dropped after January 8, 2010.</p>

The cost for both verbal and math is \$260.
The cost for one course only is \$140.
Out-of-County Residents: The cost is \$152.50 per course.
