July 14 through July 31 (Session B courses)  
(SAT COURSES are the exception – see listings)

**Hours:** 8:00 AM to 12:00 Noon daily unless otherwise noted. **No transportation provided.**

**Tuition:** Listed with course information sheet following. Courses are open to all public and non-public school students. Students living outside of Chester County will be charged an additional \$25.00.

**Registration:** A \$10 **non-refundable** fee will be charged for each course for which a student registers. This fee will be refunded only if the intermediate unit cancels the course. Courses with fewer than 17 students enrolled may not be held.

*Registrations are accepted on a first-come, first-served basis according to the postmark. Once the designated maximum for a particular course has been filled, students will have to take the course at another time. Registration forms available online <http://www.cciu.org> beginning 2/19/08.*

- **Phone registrations will be accepted after JUNE 19, 2008 for available classes only.**  
Since our program is provided on a self-supporting basis, courses with fewer than 17 students enrolled may not be held. If demand for a course exceeds available resources, students will be admitted according to the date of their registration. Courses will not be conducted when certified teachers are not available.

Fees must be paid in full at the time of registration. Because classes are scheduled based upon the number of students who enroll, no refund of fee will be made if a student drops a course after it has begun. Students will be notified of course cancellation no later than June 20. Tuition will be refunded if the course is cancelled. A refund (less a \$40 administrative fee, including \$10 non-refundable fee) will be made if a student registers for a course and drops the course by June 19, 2008.

## **General Information**

### **Attendance**

Students should make every effort to be in attendance each day. A day of summer school is equivalent to approximately four days of regular school. Absences in excess of three days for a six-week course and two days for a three-week course will result in dismissal and/or receiving no credit for the course. Excuses are required for absence and lateness. Chronic lateness for school or after breaks may also result in receiving no credit for the course. Students are expected to arrive for class at the indicated time. Each thirty (30) minutes of cumulative lateness will be equal to one absence. Additionally, five (5) lates will equal one absence. No allowance will be made for vacations; absences due to vacation are not excused. If a student is dropped due to poor attendance or is not awarded credit for a course, no money will be refunded. **No absences permitted for Health courses.**

### **Progress Reports/Report Cards**

Progress reports/report cards will not be mailed. They will be presented to students at the conclusion of the course, unless indicated in a particular class. Numerical grades will be assigned. A grade of 65 or above is considered passing as part of this summer school program.

### **Discipline**

Due to the voluntary nature of summer school attendance and the necessity to cover a great deal of academic content in a short period of time, it is expected that students' behavior will not require disciplinary action. Students will risk being dismissed if their behavior disrupts summer school. Dismissal will be the consequence of disciplinary concerns rather than suspensions. Tredyffrin/Easttown School District policies will be enforced during all summer school classes. Students who are referred to the office for a suspendable offense may be dismissed from summer school classes. Students who are referred to the office for a second suspendable misconduct will be excluded from summer school. Dress code must meet the criteria established by the Tredyffrin/Easttown School District. Summer school sites are tobacco-free sites, and smoking will not be tolerated. Students' smoking, tobacco use, or possession of tobacco products and smoking equipment could result in a fine and court costs as well as dismissal from summer school. Students cannot leave school premises during the class day.

### **Course Credit**

All courses are for make-up or original credit. **Original credit must have Guidance Counselor approval if student is not currently enrolled in T/E School District.**
