

**Chester County Intermediate Unit
Coatesville Area School District
2008 Summer School**

LOCATION: Coatesville Ninth & Tenth Grade Center, Coatesville Area School District

DATES: July 7 – July 31

TUITION & FEES: Courses are \$185 plus a \$10 registration fee for **students** of the Coatesville Area School District. For **non-district students**, courses are \$195 plus a \$10 registration fee. The \$10 registration fee will be charged for each course for which a student registers. This fee will be refunded **ONLY** if the intermediate unit cancels the course. Out-of-district students must pay tuition and fees in full at time of registration. Students who owe tuition from previous years will **NOT** be allowed to register.

REGISTRATION: **No registrations will be taken by phone or e-mail.**

TO REGISTER IN PERSON: Registrations will be accepted at the Coatesville 9/10 Center on Monday, June 30 and Tuesday, July 1 from 8:00 a.m. - 12:00 Noon; and Wednesday, July 2 from 8:00 a.m. - 3:00 p.m. Please bring your report cards when registering.

Since summer school is provided on a self-supporting basis, courses with fewer than 17 students enrolled may not be held. If demand for a course exceeds available resources, students will be admitted according to the date of their registration. Courses will not be conducted when certified teachers are not available. Cancellation of classes will be announced as soon as possible, but may be as late as July 3.

Because classes are scheduled based upon the number of students who enroll, no refund of fee will be made if a student drops a course after it has begun. A refund (less a \$25 administration fee) will be made if a student registers for a course and drops the course by July 2.

GENERAL INFORMATION

I. ATTENDANCE

Students are expected to be in attendance each day summer school is in session. **Absences in excess of two days will result in dismissal** and receiving no credit for the course. **NO REGISTRATIONS WILL BE TAKEN AFTER JULY 5.** Days attributed to late enrollment will be considered absences. Excuses are required for all absences and tardiness. Chronic tardiness for school or after breaks may also result in receiving no credit for the course. Students are expected to arrive at classes at the indicated time. Students who are more than twenty (20) minutes late for a class will receive an absence for that class. Additionally, three (3) instances of tardiness will equal one absence.

No allowance will be made for vacations, camps, etc. regardless of the grade being achieved by the student; absences due to vacations are not excused. If a student is dropped due to poor attendance or disciplinary reasons or is awarded no credit for the course, no money will be refunded.

II. GRADES

Report cards will be presented to students at the conclusion of the course. Numerical grades will be assigned. A grade of 70 or above is considered passing. Course content will follow the Coatesville Area School District curricula.

III. STUDENT CONDUCT

Due to the voluntary nature of summer school attendance and the necessity to cover a large amount of academic material in a short period, it is expected that students' behavior will not require disciplinary action. Students will risk being dismissed if their behavior disrupts summer school. Dismissal will be the consequence of disciplinary concerns rather than suspensions.

Coatesville Area School District policies and regulations will be enforced during the summer school program. Students who are referred to the office for a suspendable offense could be dismissed from summer school. Students are expected to dress in a clean and neat fashion. Shorts may be worn to summer school providing they meet the criteria established by the Coatesville Area School District. Students inappropriately attired will not be permitted to attend classes. Hats and other headwear are not allowed without the permission of the IU Summer School Supervisor. Summer school sites are tobacco-free sites. Students' smoking, tobacco use, or possession of tobacco products and equipment could result in a fine and court costs.

Pagers and telephones are not allowed in class without the permission of the summer school supervisors. No food will be allowed in classes. Students driving to summer school may park in the student parking lot. **BUS TRANSPORTATION IS NOT PROVIDED.**

Students must enter and leave the building through the designated entrances. Students are to report directly to class upon entering the building. Students are to leave the school grounds immediately after their classes for the day are completed. Loitering in or around the building is not permitted. Lunch procedure will be discussed on the first day of class.
