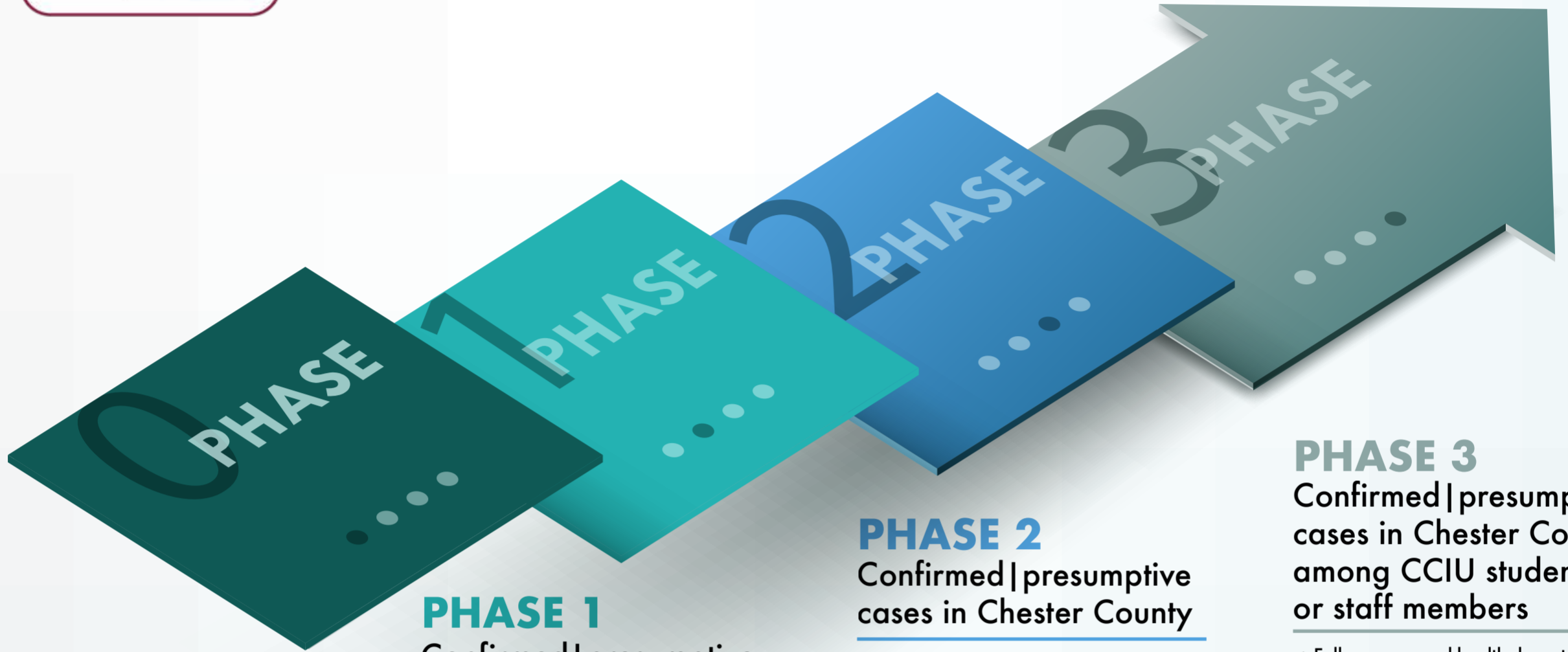




CHESTER COUNTY INTERMEDIATE UNIT PANDEMIC ACTION PLAN



PHASE 0

No confirmed | presumptive cases in the tri-state area

- Monitor the situation, giving consideration to confirmed | presumptive cases in the country.
- Provide preventive education campaign.
- Initiate and implement a Pandemic Preparedness Plan.
- Consider postponing student & staff non-essential travel to areas that are a focus of infection.
- Consult with the Chester County Department of Health for guidance & recommendations.
- Consult the Centers for Disease Control (CDC) guidelines & recommendations.
- Coordinate information sessions for Chester County school leadership.
- Consider tele-meetings & webinars as alternatives to in-person gatherings.
- Contact transportation & staffing providers to coordinate prevention efforts.
- Implement deep-cleaning procedures & increased sanitation & cleaning procedures.
- Issue notices to staff & parents of critical information & precautionary measures.
- Establish webpage with health information & updates.
- Provide Board of Directors with critical information & precautionary measures.

PHASE 1

Confirmed | presumptive cases in Pennsylvania, but none in Chester County

- Monitor quarantine protocols of known cases.
- Monitor district plans; and implement district pandemic plans as appropriate.
- Coordinate | review school closings & operations procedure with member school districts.
- Consider postponing outside group events in CCIU buildings.
- Implement tele-meetings & webinars as alternatives to in-person gatherings.
- Consider suspending student & staff non-essential travel.
- Consider suspending student volunteer | employment activities.
- Limit audience attendance at CCIU activities.
- Consult the Chester County Department of Health & Centers for Disease Control (CDC) guidance, guidelines & recommendations.
- Continue deep-cleaning procedures & increased sanitation & cleaning procedures.
- Provide the Board of Directors, staff, parents & districts with updates of critical information & precautionary measures.

PHASE 2

Confirmed | presumptive cases in Chester County

- Follow health department quarantine protocols.
- Coordinate possible CCIU school closings with member school districts.
- Implement work-from-home & other alternatives to reduce the spread of the coronavirus, in the event of a facility closure.
- Postpone outside group events in CCIU buildings.
- Implement tele-meetings & webinars as alternatives to in-person gatherings.
- Consider suspending student & staff non-essential travel.
- Consider suspending student volunteer | employment activities.
- Limit audience attendance at CCIU activities.
- Consult the Chester County Department of Health & Centers for Disease Control (CDC) guidance, guidelines & recommendations.
- Continue deep-cleaning procedures & increased sanitation & cleaning procedures.
- Provide the Board of Directors, staff & parents with updates of critical information & precautionary measures.
- Advise half-day students & families in CCIU schools & programs to follow the protocols of their sending school district in the event of a closure. Full-day students in CCIU schools & programs will follow the protocols outlined in the CCIU flu & pandemic action plan.

PHASE 3

Confirmed | presumptive cases in Chester County among CCIU students or staff members

- Follow or exceed health department quarantine protocols.
- Coordinate CCIU school closings with sending school districts.
- Implement work-from-home & other alternatives to reduce the spread of the coronavirus.
- Postpone | cancel outside group events in CCIU buildings.
- Implement tele-meetings & webinars as alternatives to in-person gatherings.
- Suspend student & staff travel.
- Suspend student volunteer | employment activities.
- Postpone all other CCIU activities.
- Follow or exceed Chester County Department of Health & Centers for Disease Control (CDC) guidance, guidelines & recommendations.
- Continue deep-cleaning procedures & increased sanitation & cleaning procedures.
- Provide the Board of Directors, staff & parents with updates of critical information.
