MINIMUM ENROLLMENT FOR CAREER AND TECHNICAL EDUCATION</p> <p><u>Minimum Occupational Program Enrollment</u></p> <p>The Board shall establish the minimum enrollment necessary to initiate and sustain career and technical education programs, utilizing the following guidelines:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. A minimum of twelve (12) students shall be necessary to initiate or maintain a half-day program.</li><li>2. A minimum of twenty-five (25) students shall be necessary to initiate or maintain a full-day program.</li><li>3. Program status shall be determined by June 1 of each school year and be based on projected enrollment for the next school year.</li><li>4. An existing program that falls below the minimum enrollment standard shall either be immediately placed on probationary status, with the teacher notified in writing, or closed for the following school year.</li><li>5. An existing program may operate below the minimum enrollment standard for a maximum of two (2) consecutive school years without being reduced or closed.</li><li>6. Extenuating circumstances shall be considered prior to a decision to reduce or close an existing program, or prior to a decision on whether a new program will be initiated.</li></ol> <p>References:</p> <p>School Code – 24 P.S.
