702. GIFTS, GRANTS, DONATIONS	
1. Purpose	The Board recognizes that individuals, businesses and community organizations may wish to contribute supplies and equipment to enhance or extend the Intermediate Unit's educational programs or support services.
2. Authority SC 216	The Board has the authority to accept gifts and donations made to the Intermediate Unit.
	Gifts made to the Intermediate Unit or its component programs which are valued in excess of the amount established by the Intermediate Unit must be reported to the Board. Gifts that are accepted will be acknowledged by the Board, the Executive Director or other appropriate staff member.
SC 216	The Board reserves the right to refuse to accept any gift that does not contribute to achievement of Intermediate Unit goals or when such ownership would adversely affect the Intermediate Unit.
SC 216	Any gift accepted by the Board or its designee shall become Intermediate Unit property, may not be returned without Board approval, and is subject to the same controls and regulations as are other Intermediate Unit properties.
	The Board shall be responsible for the maintenance of any gift it accepts, unless otherwise stipulated.
	The Board shall make every effort to honor the intent of the donor in the use of the gift, but it reserves the right to utilize any gift in the best interests of the Intermediate Unit's educational programs and support services.
	In no case shall acceptance of a gift be considered an endorsement by the Board of a commercial product, business enterprise, or institution of learning.

3. Delegation of
