DRUG/ALCOHOL TESTING - COVERED DRIVERS</p> <p>The Board recognizes that the use and abuse of drugs and alcohol is a serious problem that may be present in the workplace. The Board also recognizes that a covered driver impaired by drugs or alcohol who operates Intermediate Unit buses or vehicles or transports students poses significant risks to the safety of students and others.</p> <p>A covered driver shall include any employee who drives, operates or is in the actual physical control or movement of a bus, vehicle, or a commercial vehicle owned, leased or operated by the contractor.</p> <p>The Board establishes that transportation companies contracted by the Board shall provide a program of drug and alcohol testing for covered drivers. A statement ensuring such program shall be included in the contracted agreement.</p> <p>The Board also establishes that Intermediate Unit employees who are assigned to transport students shall be subject to testing for use of alcohol and drugs consistent with Board policy and the Intermediate Unit’s Substance Abuse Plan.</p> <p>References:</p> <p>School Code – 24 P.S.
