813. OTHER INSURANCE	
1. Purpose	Proper operation of the Intermediate Unit requires that adequate, basic insurance programs be provided for the protection of the Intermediate Unit and its employees.
2. Authority SC 513, 774	<p>The Board has the authority and responsibility to provide adequate insurance coverage to protect the Intermediate Unit's interests. Such coverage shall be in accordance with established guidelines.</p> <p>In placing insurance, the Board shall be guided by the service of an insurance agent, scope of coverage provided, price of desired coverage, and assurance of coverage.</p> <p>The Board shall appoint an insurance advisor, who may be the agent of record.</p>
3. Guidelines SC 774	Liability insurance for the Intermediate Unit shall include coverage for liability as a result of acts of administrators while in the performance of their duties.
SC 513	Health care insurance , including dental, vision and prescription care, shall include coverage for administrators and regularly employed staff members in accordance with provisions of the administrative compensation plan, an individual contract, applicable collective bargaining agreement, employee handbook or Board resolution.
SC 513	Life insurance shall include coverage for administrators and regularly employed staff members in accordance with provisions of the administrative compensation plan, an individual contract, applicable collective bargaining agreement, employee handbook or Board resolution.
SC 513	Disability insurance shall include coverage for administrators and regularly employed staff members in accordance with provisions of the administrative compensation plan, an individual contract, applicable collective bargaining agreement, employee handbook or Board resolution.
